The University of Arkansas welcomes your application for admission to the Graduate School!

APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Admission to the Graduate School requires a baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited institution and a **.0 cumulative grade average on the last 60.0 credit hours of attempted course work prior to the receipt of the baccalaureate degree**. Applicants with a conferred post-baccalaureate graduate degree (excluding professional degrees) from a regionally accredited institution are automatically admissible.

INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS: International student applicants must make a score of 550 (paper test) or 79 (internet test) or better on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or a 6.5 on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS). International students on student visas (F1 or J1) are not eligible for the MSE program.

As a graduate student at the UA, you are expected to a) know and abide by the regulations for all students, as described in the Student Handbook published by the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs, and b) know and abide by the regulations contained within the Academic Honesty policy for Graduate Students and the Research Misconduct Policy. As a graduate student, it is expected that you will refrain from all acts of academic and research dishonesty and will furthermore report to the Graduate School any acts witnessed. By signing the *Application for Admission*, you are verifying your willingness to abide by the Honor Code for the duration of studies.

YOU SHOULD NOTE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION.

To ensure that your application is processed in a timely way you are encouraged to submit all application materials in one large envelope. Please do not mail items separately. Your self-managed application packet should include the following (**make sure your name and social security number or date of birth are on all items**):

1. Please refer to the Graduate School Catalog which contains important material about admission, requirements, degrees, departments, majors, and fees.
2. Please be sure to use your legal name when filling out the form. Please print all information clearly.
3. Application fee of USD \$40 (\$50 for international students), in the form of a check or money order made payable to the University of Arkansas and drawn on a U.S. bank.
4. **TRANSCRIPT INSTRUCTIONS:** You will need to request an OFFICIAL transcript from EACH college or university you have ever attended. If a degree was earned, the official transcript must confirm the degree and the date it was received. (Note: The act that courses you took at one institution may be included on a transcript from another institution will not suffice.)

5. IF YOU HAVE NOT YET RECEIVED YOUR BACCALAUREATE DEGREE: At the time of your application, you must have an official transcript from the degree-granting institution sent to the program site. AFTER completion of your degree, you must have the official transcript showing confirmation of the receipt of the degree sent to your program site.
6. IF YOU WERE PREVIOUSLY ENROLLED OR ARE CURRENTLY ENROLLED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS, FAYETTEVILLE: Anyone who was previously enrolled, but who is not currently enrolled in the GRADUATE SCHOOL, is required only to submit an Application for Admission (\$25 fee) and official transcripts from institutions attended after you last enrolled in the Graduate School.
7. OFFICIAL NOTICE of the decision on your admission will be sent from the Graduate School. **ENROLLMENT IN A CLASS DOES NOT CONSTITUTE ADMISSION TO THE GRADUATE SCHOOL.**
8. VETERAN'S BENEFITS: Students will not be certified for veteran's benefits until they have been officially admitted to the Graduate School. **ENROLLMENT IN A CLASS DOES NOT CONSTITUTE ADMISSION TO THE GRADUATE SCHOOL.**
